Certificate of Compliance Minnesota Workers' Compensation Law

PRINT IN INK or TYPE.

Minnesota Statutes, Section 176.182 requires every state and local licensing agency to withhold the issuance or renewal of a license or permit to operate a business or engage in any activity in Minnesota until the applicant presents acceptable evidence of compliance with the workers' compensation insurance coverage requirement of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 176. The required workers' compensation insurance information is the name of the insurance company, the policy number, and the dates of coverage, or the permit to self-insure. If the required information is not provided or is falsely stated, it shall result in a \$2,000 penalty assessed against the applicant by the commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry.

A valid workers' compensation policy must be kept in effect at all times by employers as required by law.

As a licensed tobacco products or cigarette retailer, I understand that:

1. I can purchase cigarettes only from a Minnesota distributor or subjobber who holds a license with the Minnesota Department of Revenue.
2. I must obtain a tobacco products distributor license if I purchase untaxed tobacco products from an out-of-state company.
3. I may not sell cigarettes affixed with Minnesota Native American stamps unless my retail business is located on a reservation that has a tax agreement with the State of Minnesota.
4. I may not purchase from or exchange cigarettes or tobacco products with another retailer.
5. I must keep complete and legible cigarette and tobacco products invoices on the licensed premises, or make invoices available within one hour of request, for at least one year after the date of the purchase.
6. I know that the Minnesota Department of Revenue and/or law enforcement may conduct cigarette and tobacco inspections of the premises, including inspections of inventory, invoices and licenses, and I understand that a refusal to allow an inspection is grounds for revocation of my license.
7. I know that failure to comply with all requirements can result in criminal penalties, including the loss of cigarettes and tobacco products.

Re: Support for the Prairie Island Indian Community

Dear Mr. Hagedorn,

On behalf of Mayor Rod Steele and the Pine Island City Council, we are reaching out to you today in support of the Prairie Island Indian Community and its effort to obtain additional reservation lands near Pine Island, Minnesota. Due to major Federal infrastructure projects, the safety and security of this tribe and its reservation land at Prairie Island has become imperiled. We are writing to you seeking a legislative solution to this issue.

Minnesota has long been the ancestral home of the Prairie Island Community--long before European settlement. The existing location of the Tribe's reservation land, located along the Mississippi River, has been adversely impacted by Lock and Dam No. 3 which has caused ongoing flooding of significant portions of Tribal lands.

In addition to flooding, the operation of the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant—approximately 600 yards from the reservation—has compounded the threat to the safety and security of the Prairie Island Indian Community. **Indeed, no other community in the nation is closer to a nuclear power plant.** The federal government further exacerbated the threat by authorizing the placement of 1.6 million pounds of spent nuclear fuel, stored in 44 casks with an additional 54 casks by 2034. Complicating matters even more, there is only one public access road into and out of Prairie Island—which is often blocked by rail traffic. As you can see, this is a public safety concern in terms of not only evacuation, should it become necessary, but also delaying public safety responses to routine emergencies as well as man-made and natural disasters.

The Prairie Island Indian Community has purchased land, formerly known as “Elk Run” in Pine Island, Minnesota, to remedy these threats and settle subsequent claims against the federal government for enabling them. Congressional confirmation of this land as an additional

reservation for the Tribe would ensure the long-term safety and security of the Tribe and its people.

The City of Pine Island believes that the Tribe is committed to working closely with the community and in partnership with our regional stakeholders to bring much needed jobs and substantial development of this property as well as economic development to the region. We believe that the purchase and development of this property is a winning scenario, not only for the community of Pine Island, but the region as well. The Mayor and Council of the City of Pine Island respectfully asks you to support the enactment of appropriate federal legislation to confirm the reservation status of these lands.

Thank you for your work on behalf of the great state of Minnesota.
